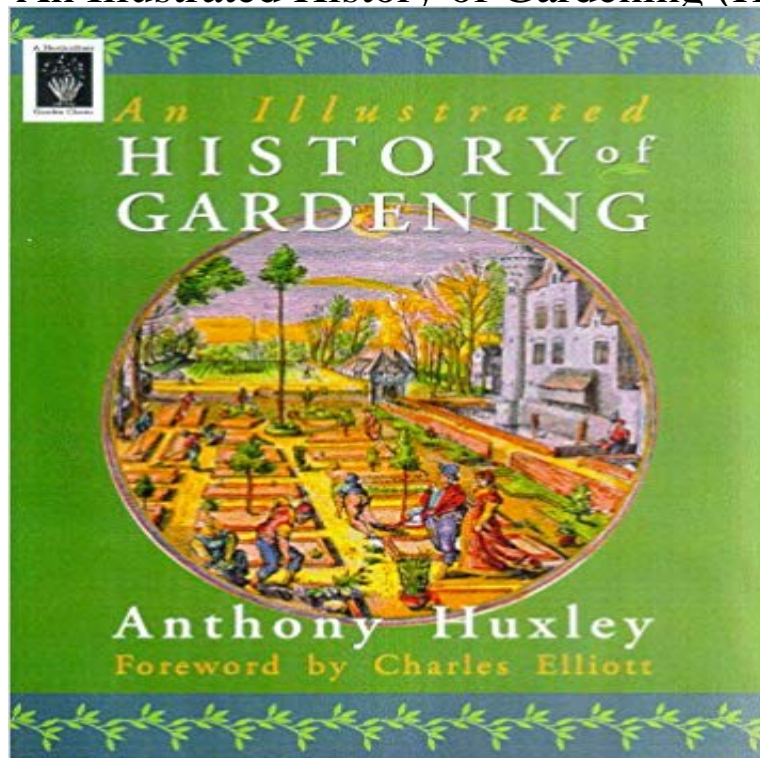


An Illustrated History of Gardening (Horticulture Garden Classic)
