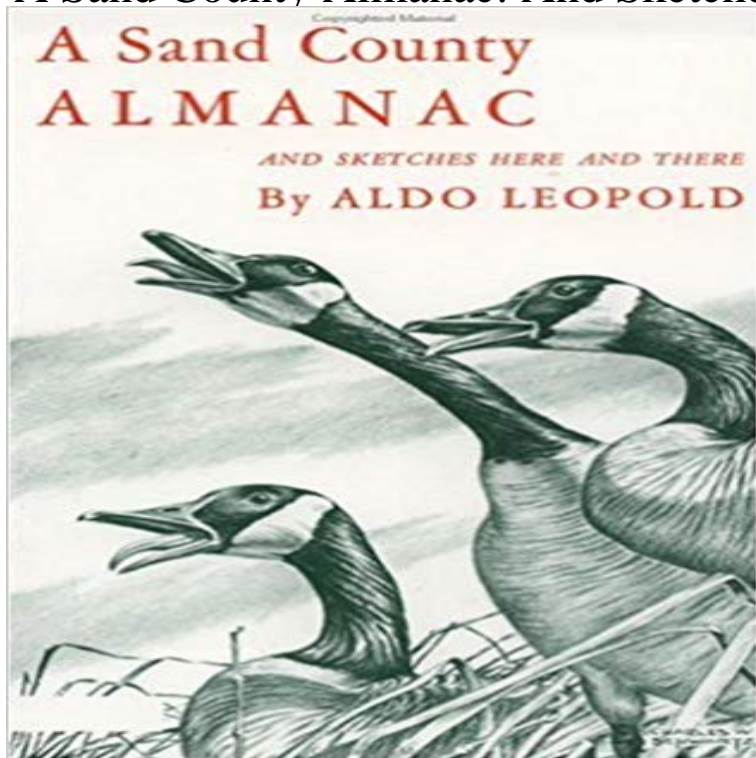


A Sand County Almanac: And Sketches Here and There
