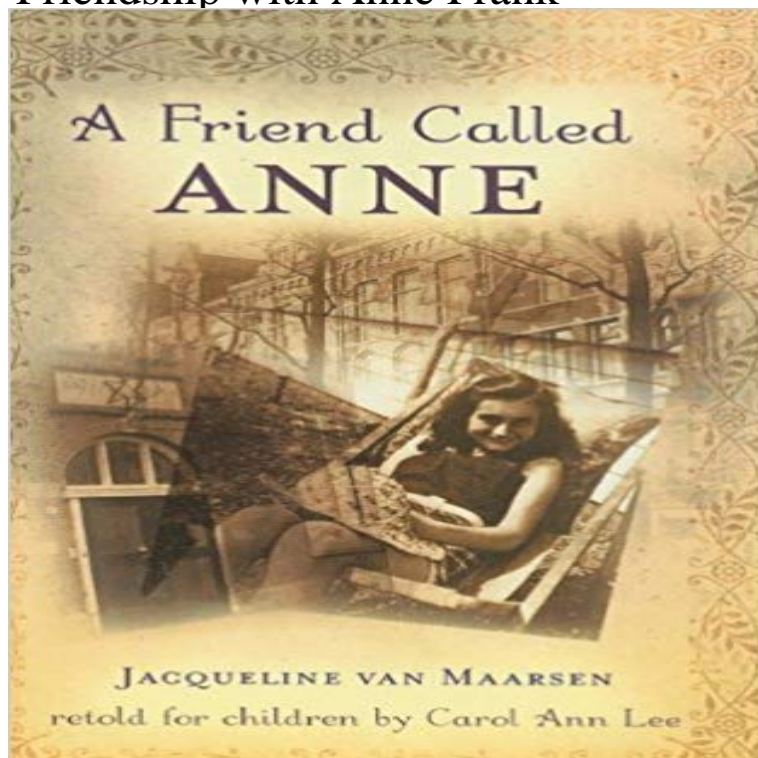


A Friend Called Anne: One Girls Story of War, Peace, and a Unique Friendship with Anne Frank
