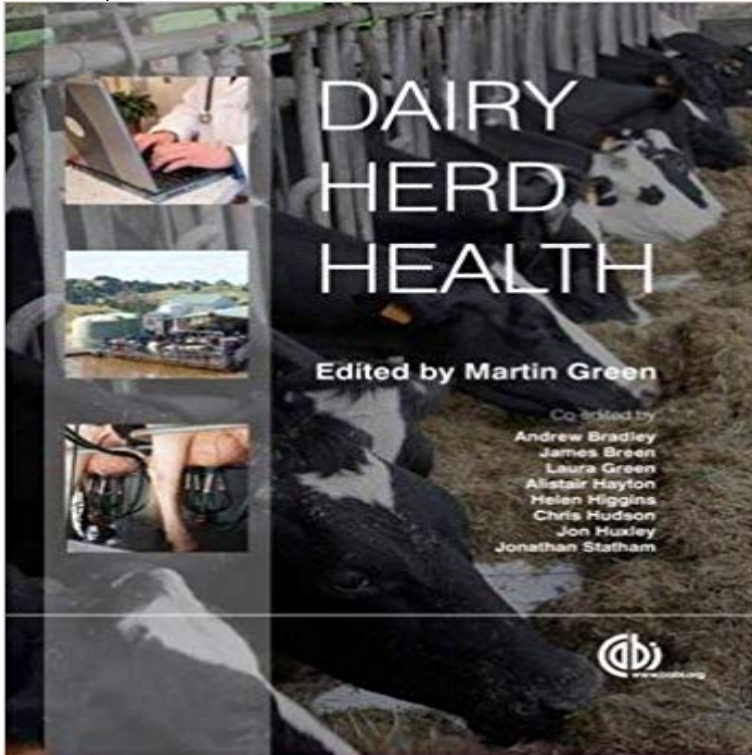


# Dairy Herd Health
