

Home Health Aide On-the-Go In-Service Lessons: Vol. 10, Issue 4: Flu and Pneumonia



OVERVIEW Influenza (flu) and pneumonia are serious diseases for both older adults and healthcare workers. Home health aides must be familiar with the facts about flu and pneumonia, as well as infection control measures to prevent the spread of these diseases. This in-service describes flu and pneumonia symptoms and teaches home health aides how to recognize the signs of both illnesses. It also defines who is eligible for a vaccination and explains how to take precautionary measures to prevent the spread of these diseases.

- Describe who should get an influenza vaccination
- Describe who should get a pneumonia vaccination
- List the signs of a swallowing problem
