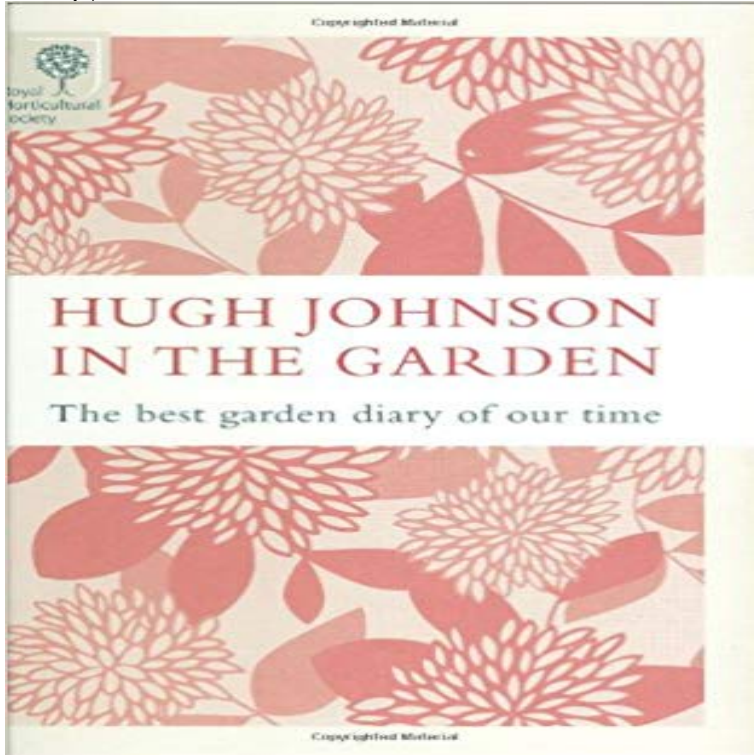


Hugh Johnson in the Garden: The Best Garden Diary of Our Time
