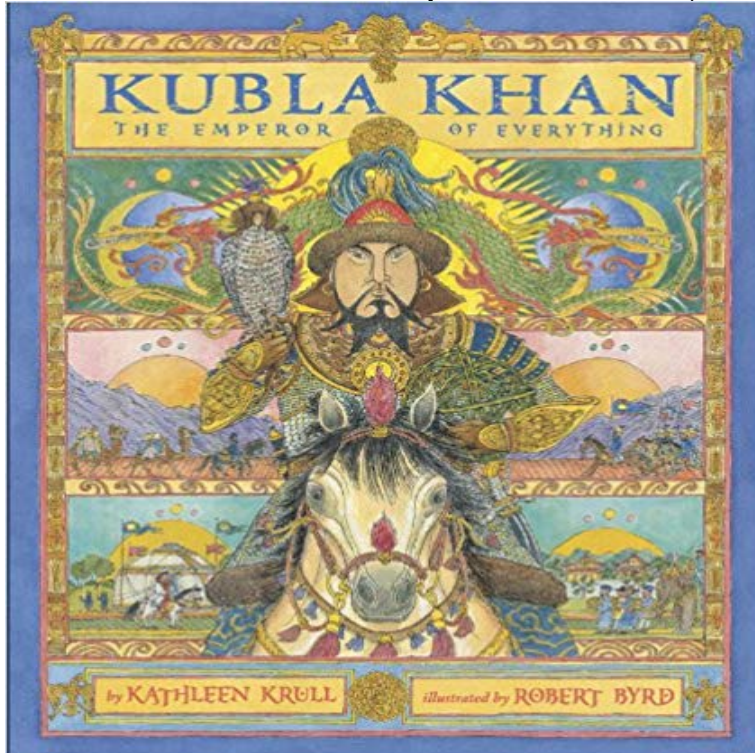


# Kubla Khan: The Emperor of Everything
