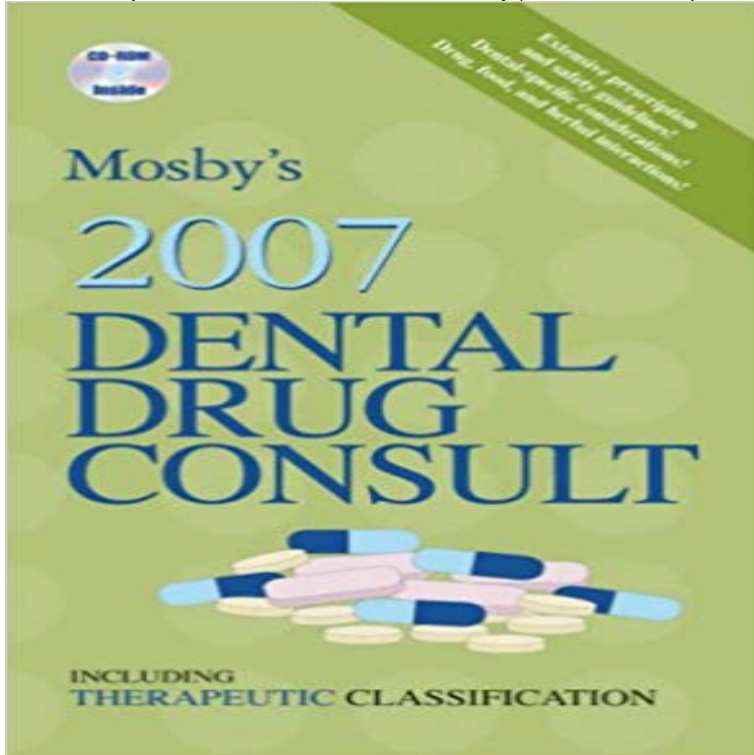


# Mosbys 2007 Dental Drug Consult, 1e (Mosbys Dental Drug Consult)

Includes a section on Medically Compromised Patients. Dental alert icons highlight oral side effects. Drug interaction icons designate interactions of concern to dentistry. Maple leaf icons indicate common brand names for the generic drug sold only in Canada. Provides information on the top 200 prescription drugs in the United States. Provides complete monographs for 50 herbal and nonherbal remedies. Includes complete and consistent monographs of more than 850 commonly used drug products. Focuses on drug interactions of clinical interest. Offers pregnancy risk category, controlled substance schedule, and over-the-counter status. Alphabetic index. Therapeutic/pharmacologic index. The Dental Considerations section in individual drug monographs includes dental treatment warnings related to medical indications for the drug. It also offers treatment plan modifications related to drug side effects. A CD-ROM bound in the back of each book contains 30 full-color pathologic

conditions that may result from drugs patients are taking. Each drug is cross-referenced to the page in the book where the drug is discussed. The CD also contains 950 patient education sheets (customizable to include specific practice information). These sheets provide patients with invaluable drug information and specific instructions, and all are available in both English and Spanish.
