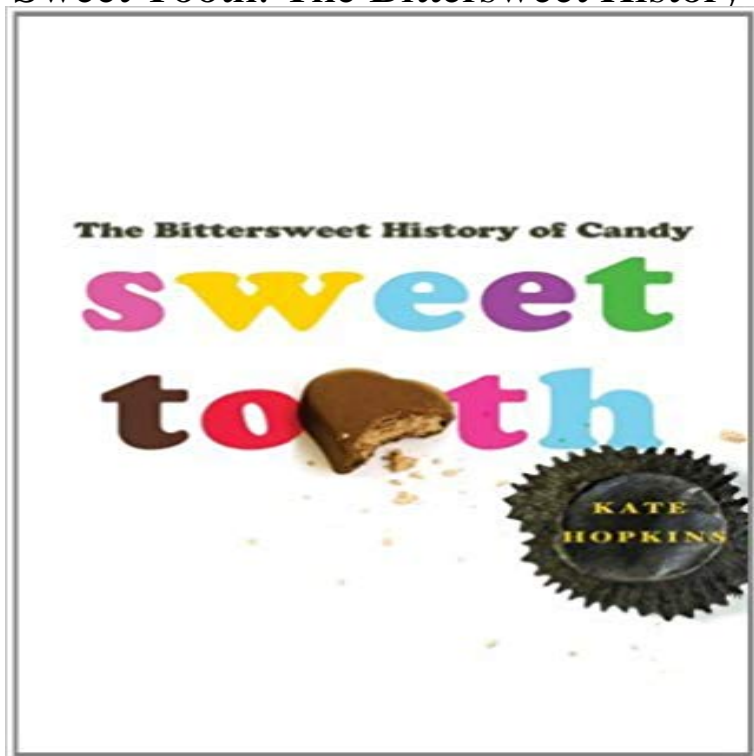


Sweet Tooth: The Bittersweet History of Candy
