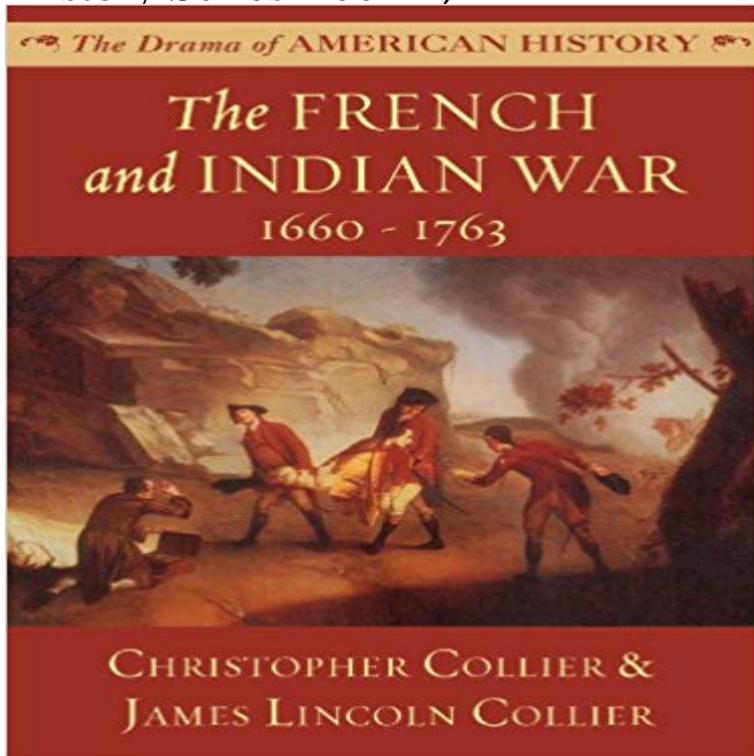


The French and Indian War: 1660 - 1763 (The Drama of American History Series Book 4)
