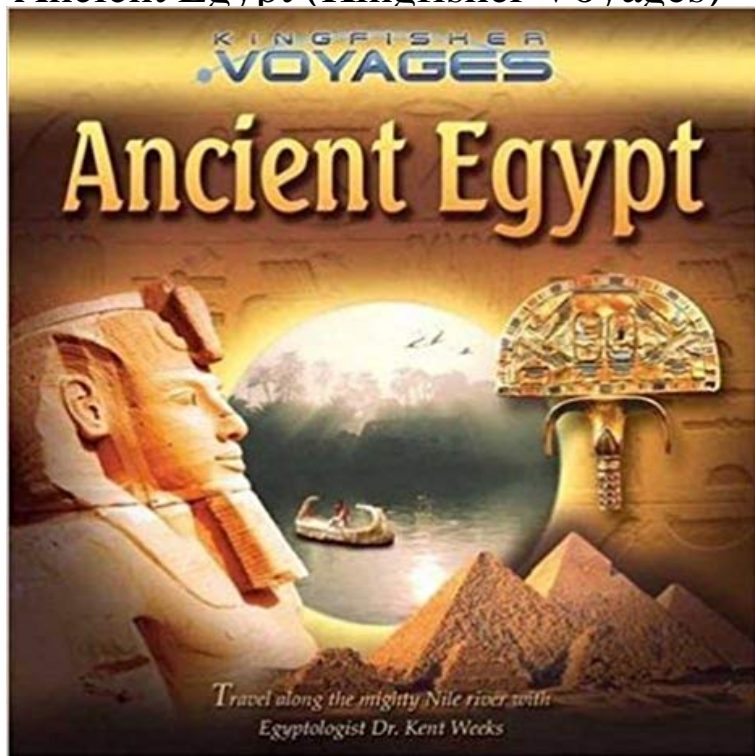


## Ancient Egypt (Kingfisher Voyages)
