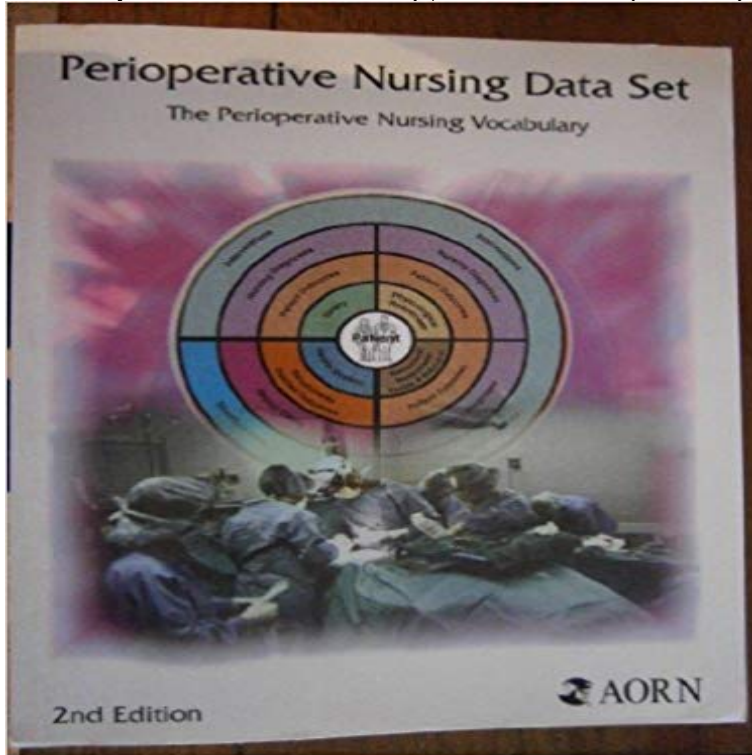


Perioperative Nursing Data Set (Pnds)
